OFFICE MEMORANDUM

NO.FIN/ESTT-3/04(Pt) (Vol-I)

Dated Kohima, the 02nd December, 2022.

Coverage under Central Civil Services (Pension) Rules, 1972, in place of National Pension System, of those State Government employees whose selection for appointment was finalised before 01.01.2010 but joined Government service on or after 01.01.2010.

- The undersigned is directed to say that consequent on introduction of National Pension System (NPS) vide Notification No. FIN/ESTT-3/04 (pt) dated 28th January 2010, all Government servants appointed on or after 01.01.2010 to the posts in the State Government service are mandatorily covered under the said scheme.
- Representations have been received from the Government servants appointed on or after 01.01.2010 requesting the benefit of the pension scheme under Central Civil (Service) Pension Rules, 1972 on the ground that their appointment was delayed on account of Administrative reasons.
- 3. The matter has been examined in consultation with the Personnel & Administrative Reforms department and in light of the decision of the Government of India, Department of Pension & Pensioner Welfare vide Office Memorandum No. 57/04/2019-P&PW(B) dated 17th February 2020 and 25th June 2020, it has been decided that in all cases where the results for recruitment were declared before 01.01.2010 against vacancies occurring on or before 31.12.2009, the candidates declared successful for recruitment shall be eligible for coverage under the CCS (Pension) Rules, 1972.
- 4. Accordingly, such Government servant who were declared successful for recruitment in the results declared on or before 31.12.2009 against vacancies occurring before 01.01.2010 and are covered under the National Pension System on joining service on or after 01.01.2010, may be given a one-time option to be covered under the CCS(Pension) Rules, 1972. This option may be exercised by the concerned Government servants latest by **31.03.2023**.
- This option is subject to the condition that only those recruitment done by observing the standing policy of the Government as laid down in P&AR O.M. No. AR-5/ASSO/98(B) dated 26th August, 1998 shall be eligible/considered for exercising the one time option.
- 6. This one-time option shall also cover the following Government servants:
 - a. A Government servant who joined Government service on or after 01.01.2010 on the basis of results declared before 01.01.2010 against vacancies occurred prior to 01.01.2010 and thereafter joined another Government service with proper permission after tendering technical resignation is also eligible to exercise the one-time option.

- b. A government servant, who joined on or after 01.01.2010 on appointment on compassionate grounds, shall be eligible to exercise the one-time option, if the competent authority had taken decision on the recommendation of the Screening/Selection Committee to appoint the Government servant on compassionate grounds before 01.01.2010.
- c. If a Government servant, who otherwise was eligible for the one-time option has already died, the option exercised by the member of the family who is eligible to receive NPS benefits on the death of the Government servant may be accepted.
- Those Government servants who are eligible to exercise the option in accordance to para-4 above, but who do not exercise this option within the stipulated date shall continue to be covered by the National Pension System.
- 8. The option once exercised shall be final.
- 9. This option **shall not** be extended to Government servants appointed on or after 01.01.2010 if they fall in any of the following categories:
 - a. Government servant whose name were included in a panel of selected candidates before 01.01.2010 for recruitment against vacancies occurring on or after 01.01.2010 and were, accordingly recruited on or after 01.01.2010.
 - Government servant whose name was included in a panel of selected candidates prepared before 01.01.2010 for vacancies arising before and after 01.01.2010 but was actually appointed after 31.12.2009 against vacancy arising on or after 01.01.2010.
 - c. Government servants who were selected against vacancies pertaining to the period prior to 01.01.2010 on the basis of an advertisement/notification issued before 01.01.2010 or a written examination/interview held before 01.01.2010 but results declared for recruitment were declared on or after 01.01.2010.
 - d. Government servants who joined on or after 01.01.2010 after they were granted extension of joining time on their own request and, in accordance with the instructions issued by the Personnel & Administrative Reforms Department, their seniority was depressed on account of such extension of joining time to a batch for which the result for recruitment was declared on or after 01.01.2010.

No. FIN/ESTT-2/17/NJS/18: Whereas, the Hon'ble Supreme Court by order dated 09.05.2017 in W.P.(C) No.643/2015 (All India Judges Association Vs. Union of India & Others) constituted the Second National Judicial Pay Commission with Mr. Justice P. Venkatarama Reddy, former Judge of Supreme Court of India as its Chairman and Mr. Justice R. Basant former Judge of the Kerala High Court as its member.

- And whereas, the constitution of the Second National Judicial Pay Commission was notified on 16.11.2017 with the following terms of reference:
 - to evolve the principles which should govern the structure of pay and other emoluments of Judicial Officers
 - ii) to examine the existing structure of emoluments and conditions of service and to make recommendations including post retirement benefits.
 - iii) to examine the work methods and work environment as also the variety of allowances and benefits and to suggest rationalization.
- And whereas the Commission submitted its report in January 2020 before the Hon'ble Supreme Court.
- And whereas, the Hon'ble Supreme Court issued directions on 27.07.2022 to the State Governments for implementation of the Second National Judicial Pay Commission.
- 5. Now, therefore, in compliance to the above directions of the Hon'ble Supreme Court, the Governor of Nagaland is pleased to order that the pay scales and other financial benefits as recommended by the Second National Judicial Pay Commission and as endorsed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India shall be admissible to the Officers of the Nagaland Judicial Services under the Government of Nagaland.
- The existing Master Pay Scale is replaced by the pay matrix pattern on the model of 7th Central Pay Commission. The revised pay matrix is enclosed as table-1.

- accrual of increment, the retiring Judicial Officers shall have the benefit of increment becoming due the next day following the retirement. This increment shall be for the purpose of pension only and subject to vertical ceiling of Rs.2,24,100/-.
- 9. The new pay matrix shall come into effect from 01.01.2016.
- 10. Mode of payment of arrears:

Vide notification of even number dated 30th May 2018, 40% of Dearness Allowance was merged with the basic pay as an interim relief. While computing arrears on account of revision of pay, the interim relief shall be adjusted and the remaining amount of arrears shall be paid in the following manner:

- i) 50% of arrears to be paid in cash within January 2023.
- The remaining 50% of arrears to be paid in cash on or before the end of June 2023.
- 11. Allowances:

 - viii. Hilly area/tough location allowance @ Rs.5000/- per month.
 - ix. Home orderly/domestic help allowance shall be the minimum wages for one unskilled worker in the concerned State subject to minimum of Rs.10,000/- per month in respect of District Judges and 60% of the minimum wages for one unskilled worker subject to a minimum of Rs.7500/- per month in respect of Civil Judges.

- Domestic help Allowance to pensioners shall be Rs.9000/- per month and Rs.7500/- per month for family pensioner. It shall be increased by 30% with effect from 01.01.2021.
- xi. House Rent Allowance: Residential quarters shall be of a minimum plinth area 2500 sq. ft. for District Judges and 2000 sq. ft. for Civil Judges.
- xii. One leave travel concession and one home travel concession in a block of three years shall be made available.
- xiii. Encashment of 10 days Earned Leave while availing LTC shall continue in addition to encashment of 300 days at the time of retirement.
- xiv. Fixed medical allowance shall be Rs.3000/- per month to the serving Judicial Officers and fixed medical allowance to the pensioners and family pensioners shall be Rs.4000/- per month w.e.f. 01.01.2016.
- xv. Re-imbursement of newspapers and magazines shall be Rs.1000/- for District Judges and Rs.700/- per month for Civil Judges. This allowance shall be effective from 01.01.2020.
- xvi. Robe Allowance shall be Rs.12000/- to be paid once in three years w.e.f. 01.01.2016.
- xvii. Special pay for administrative work shall be Rs.7000/- per month for Principal District and Sessions Judges and Rs.3500/- per month for other District Judges and Rs.2000/- per month for officers below the rank of District Judges.
- xviii. Sumptuary Allowance shall be Rs.7800/- per month for District Judges, Rs.5800/- per month for Civil Judges (Sr. Div) and Rs.3800/- per month for Civil Judges (Jr. Div).
 - xix. Residential telephone, broadband facility and mobile handset shall be provided.
 - xx. Transfer grant shall be at the rate of one month's basic pay.
- 12. Pension:
 - National Pension System shall not be applicable to Judicial Officers and they shall continue to be covered under the Old Pension Scheme.

2. Whereas. Rule 28 of the Registration of Electors Rules, 1960, empowers the Election Commission to direct, with a view to preventing impersonation of electors and facilitating their identification at the time of poll, the issue of Electors Photo Identity Card to electors bearing their photographs at State cost; and

3. Whereas, Rules 49H (3) and 49K (2) (b) of the Conduct of Elections Rules. 1961. stipulate that where the electors of a constituency have been supplied with Electors Photo Identity Card under the said provisions of Rule 28 of the Registration of Electors Rules, 1960. the electors shall produce their Elector Photo Identity Card at the polling station and failure or refusal on their part to produce those Elector Photo Identity Card may result in the denial of permission to vote; and

4. Whereas, a combined and harmonious reading of the aforesaid provisions of the said Act and the Rules, makes it clear that although the right to vote arises by the existence of the name in the electoral roll, it is also dependent upon the use of the Elector Photo Identity Card, where provided by the Election Commission at State cost, as the means of establishing their identity at the time of polling and that both are to be used together; and

5. Whereas, the Election Commission made an Order on the 28th August, 1993, directing the issue of Elector Photo Identity Card (EPIC) to all electors, according to a time bound programme; and

 Whereas, Elector Photo Identity Card have been issued to approximate 100% electors in the States of Meghalaya, Nagaland, Tripura, Arunachal Pradesh, Jharkhand, Tamil Nadu, West Bengal & Maharashtra; and

Now, therefore, after taking into account all relevant factors and the legal and factual 7. position, the Election Commission hereby directs that for the current General Election to the Legislative Assembly of Tripura notified on 21-01-2023, General Election to the Legislative Assemblies of Mcghalaya & Nagaland and bye elections to 01-Lumla(ST) Assembly Constituency of Arunachal Pradesh, 23-Ramgarh Assembly Constituency of Jharkhand, 98-Erode(East) Assembly Constituency of Tamil Nadu, 60-Sagardighi Assembly Constituency of West Bengal and 215-Kasba Peth & 205-Chinchwad Assembly Constituencies of Maharashtra notified on 31-01-2023, all electors who have been issued EPIC shall produce the EPIC for their identification at

the polling stations before casting their votes. Those electors who are not able to produce the EPIC shall produce one of the following alternative photo identity documents for establishing their identity: -

- (i) Aadhaar Card,
- (ii) MNREGA Job Card.
- (iii)Passbooks with photograph issued by Bank/Post Office,
- (iv) Health Insurance Smart Card issued under the scheme of Ministry of Labour,
- (v) Driving License,
- (vi) PAN Card,
- (vii) Smart Card issued by RGI under NPR,
- (viii) Indian Passport,
- (ix) Pension document with photograph,
- (x) Service Identity Cards with photograph issued to employees by Central/State Govt./PSUs Public Limited Companies,
- (xi) Official identity cards issued to MPs MLAs/MLCs, and
- (xii)Unique Disability ID (UDID) Card, M/o Social Justice & Empowerment, Government of India

8. In the case of EPIC, clerical errors, spelling mistakes, etc. should be ignored provided the identity of the elector can be established by the EPIC. If an elector produces an EPIC which has been issued by the Electoral Registration Officer of another Assembly Constituency, such EPIC shall also be accepted for identification provided the name of that elector finds place in the electoral roll pertaining to the polling station where the elector has turned up for voting. If it is not possible to establish the identity of the elector on account of mismatch of photograph, etc. the elector shall have to produce one of the alternative photo documents mentioned in Para 7 above.

9.
