	i. Assistant Program Officer / Associate Program Officer

- (ii) Each of the grades of posts specified above shall form an independent grade and a member of one grade shall have no claim for appointment to the higher grade, except in accordance with the provisions of these Rules.

4. Strength of Service and Pay Scale

The strength of the service at the commencement of these Rules, both permanent and temporary, as well as the pay scales attached to various grades of posts in the service shall be as specified in **Schedule-I**, provided that the Government may reduce or add to any of the posts from time to time by notification.

5. Age

The minimum age for direct recruitment shall be such as may be prescribed by the Government, from time to time as per P & AR notification.

6. Disqualifications

- (i) No person shall be qualified for appointment to the service unless he is a citizen of India.
- (ii) No person who has more than one spouse living shall be eligible for appointment to any post under these Rules.

Provided that if any person after joining the service under these rules marries again when the first spouse is living and divorce or separation has not taken place, he shall be disqualified from the service unless the Government is satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person.

- (iii) Candidates who are already in Government service or in the service under Statutory Bodies shall not be appointed unless Release Certificate or No Objection Certificate from the Government or the employer is furnished.
- (iv) No person shall be appointed to the service whose character and antecedents are adversely reported upon by a competent authority.
- (v) No person who attempts to enlist support for his candidature directly or indirectly through any recommendation either written or oral shall be appointed to the service.

7. Source of recruitment

Recruitment referred to in schedule II shall be after the commencement of this rule be made as follows:

7.1. Departmental Promotion**7.1.1. Method of promotion**

- (i) For the purpose of recruitment by promotion / placement under Rule(7) read with Schedule II there shall be a Departmental Promotion Committee (DPC) consisting of the following members:

However, the Director shall not be a member of the Committee for preparation of the select list for promotion to the post of Director, in which event, the Secretary of the Department of Information Technology & Communication shall become the Member Secretary.

- (ii) Whenever any vacancy / vacancies arise in the service to be filled in by promotion, the Head of Department shall furnish the following particulars together with his comment if any to the Secretary in the given proforma prescribed by the commission for the purpose:
 - a. The Annual Confidential Report or appraisal report for preceding 5(five) years or less as the case may apply.
 - b. Final seniority list
 - c. Integrity certificate / vigilance clearance
 - d. Any other relevant document in respect of the eligible persons.
- (iii) The promotion / placement shall be strictly made on the basis of merit-cum-seniority.
- (iv) On the receipt of the documents specified under sub-rule (ii) by the Committee and after such clarifications as may be required, the Committee shall meet and prepare a select list of candidates eligible for placement or promotion to the higher grade along with the date from which they are eligible during the calendar year equal to the number of vacancies or anticipated vacancies.

7.1.2. Director

The post of director shall be filled up by promotion from the rank of Additional Director. Provided that the candidate has the requisite qualification as per **Schedule –II**, must be a substantive incumbent with minimum of 3(three) year of continuous service in the next lower grade ie Additional Director.

7.1.3. Additional Director

The post of Additional Director shall be filled up by promotion from the rank of Joint Director. Provided that the candidate has the requisite qualification as per **schedule -II**, must be a substantive incumbent with a minimum of 5(five) year of continuous service in the next lower grade ie as Joint Director on vacancy.

7.1.4. Joint Director

The post of Joint Director shall be filled up by promotion from the rank of Deputy Director. Provided that the candidate has the requisite qualification as per **schedule –II**, must be a substantive incumbent with a minimum of 6(five) year of continuous service in the next lower grade ie as Deputy Director on vacancy.

7.1.5. Deputy Director / Senior Program Officer / Senior Technical Officer

The post of Deputy Director / Senior Program Officer / Senior Technical Officer shall be filled up by promotion from the rank of Program Officer provided that the candidate has the requisite qualification as per **schedule –II**, must be a

substantive incumbent with a minimum of 7(seven) year of continuous service in the next lower grade ie as Program Officer on availability of clear –cut vacancy.

7.1.6. Program Officer / Technical Officer

- (i) The post of Program Officer shall be filled up by promotion from the rank of Associate Program Officer / Assistant Program Officer / Associate Technical Officer. Provided that the candidate has the requisite qualification as per **schedule –II**, must be a substantive incumbent with a minimum of 7 (seven) year of continuous service in the next lower grade ie as Associate Program Officer / Assistant Program Officer on vacancy.
- (ii) 50% of the vacancies arising in a year for Program officer / Technical Officer shall be filled up by direct recruitment through the Commission. Seniority of person recruited under this rule shall be fixed in accordance with the merit list prepared by the commission
- (iii) 50% of the vacancies arising in a year for Program officer / Technical Officer will be filled up by promotion from the panel of serving Assistant Program Officer / Associate Program Officer as per schedule –II.

7.1.7. Assistant Program Officer / Associate Program Officer / Associate Technical Officer

70% of the vacancies arising in a year for Assistant Program Officer / Associate Program Officer / Associate Technical Officer shall be filled up by direct recruitment through the Commission. Seniority of person recruited under this rule shall be fixed in accordance with the merit list prepared by the commission. 30% of the post shall be filled by serving employees with requisite qualification as per schedule – II.

7.2. Direct Recruitment

- (i) Whenever there is a vacancy or expected vacancy in the service to be filled up by direct recruitment under these Rules, the Department shall immediately send a requisition in the form prescribed by the Commission indicating the subject(s) or academic disciplines and the number of vacancies.
- (ii) The Commission shall advertise the post(s) specifying as far as possible the terms and conditions under these Rules and the number of vacancies to be filled up.
- (iii) A candidate must apply on or before such date and in such manner and in such form as may be prescribed by the Commission.
- (iv) A written test with interview for the selection to the post shall be held at such time and place as may be prescribed in the notices issued by the Commission for the purpose.
- (v) The Commission shall arrange the names of all selected candidates in order of merit, which shall be determined in accordance with the aggregate marks obtained by each candidate and if two or more candidate obtained equal marks, the commission shall arrange their names in order of academic records. The

Commission shall forward to the Government the names of successful candidates in the order of merit equal to the number of vacancies requisitioned for direct recruitment. Further, a waiting list equal to the number of vacancies reported in each of the disciplines requisitioned will be prepared by the Commission. The appointment shall be made as per the merit list.

- (vi) Provided that the arrangement of names of the qualified candidates in order of merit shall be subject to the reservation policy as per instructions issued by the Government from time to time.
- (vii) The inclusion of names of candidates shall confer no right to the candidates for appointment unless the Government is satisfied after such inquiry as may be considered necessary that the candidate is suitable in all respects for appointment to service.
- (viii) A candidate for direct recruitment to the service shall be required to possess the qualification as prescribed against each post in Schedule-II.

8. Probation

- (i) Persons appointed directly to the service through the Commission shall be on probation for a period of one year.
- (ii) The appointing authority may extend the period of probation by a period not exceeding one year if deemed necessary in appropriate cases.
- (iii) The appointing authority may dispense with the services of a probationer if during or at the end of the probation period or extension thereof the probationer is considered to be unfit for regular appointment.
- (iv) On successful completion of probation, the State Government will regularize the appointment of the probationer to the service;
- (v) Provided that regular members of service at the commencement of these Rules will be deemed to have been given regular appointment from the date of entry into service.
- (vi) The period of probation completed successfully shall be counted in full as qualifying service for all purposes.

9. Seniority

- (i) The seniority of members of the services recruited in any year in a particular cadre shall be in the order of merit drawn up under Rule (7). However, the inter-se seniority between those officers recruited through direct recruitment, and those recruited through promotion during the same calendar year shall be determined in accordance with government orders notified from time to time.
- (ii) A member of the service who gets placement in the next higher grade through DPC shall automatically become senior to other members of the service who continue to be in the lower grade.

10. Confirmation

When a probationer has completed his probation period to the satisfaction of the appointing authority, he shall be confirmed in the service if:

- (i) The member of the service is considered fit for confirmation in consideration of all other aspects and conditions as are or may be laid down by the Government.
- (ii) The member of the service has undergone the prescribed courses or other such training that may be stipulated by the Government.

11. Training

All officials shall mandatorily undergo induction / professional / mid career and promotion-linked training programmes that may be prescribed by the Government from time to time, and also pass the examinations at the end of such training courses.

Officials failing to attend the training courses in spite of being nominated by the Government or failing to pass the examinations at the end of the training courses shall render themselves liable to be superseded by their juniors who had attended such training courses and had passed the examinations.

12. Cadre Review

Matters relating to the number of posts in various grades of Service, the addition of any posts or removal of any post from the cadre of Service, and any other matter specified in Schedule-I, shall be reviewed from time to time by a Cadre Review Committee to be constituted by P & AR Department.

13. Interpretation

Any question or doubt arising out of the interpretation of these Rules shall be referred to the Government whose decision thereon shall be final.

14. Review of Service

A review of the service of the official on attaining the age of 50(fifty) years shall be undertaken as provided under Fundamental Rules 56 (J).

15. Repeal and Saving

Any Rule corresponding to these Rules and in force immediately before the commencement of these rules, are hereby repealed in respect of all matters covered by these rules. Provided that any order made or action taken under the rule so repealed shall be deemed to have been made or taken validity under the corresponding provision of these rules.

Dated Kohima, the 9th November, 2018.**Submission of proposals to Manpower Rationalization Committee for policy decision.**

It has been observed that large numbers of proposals for upgradation of posts at different levels are being moved by various Departments. In many cases, proper justification for the proposal is absent. The Government is of the view that any proposal for upgradation of posts should be based on well laid down principals having complete functional justification and such proposals should be moved only if it is in the interest of public service. Upgradation of posts should not be considered solely for the benefit of individuals or for giving retirement benefits to individual employees.
