NO.TPT/MV/09/2019/154:: The Governor of Nagaland is pleased to lay down the following guidelines on Issue of Permit for all Passenger Service Vehicles in the State which shall come into immediate effect.

1. Under Section 73(a)(ii) and (iv) of the Motor Vehicles Rules for Excluded Areas, Assam, 1942 (Nagaland Amendment Rules, 1983) as amended vide Notification No. TPT/MV/2/79 dated 30/03/1983, Para 16, the fees for permits in respect of Passenger Service Vehicles are fixed as under:

- (i) In respect of a Taxi Cab/Tourist Taxi Rs. 200/- per year.
- (ii) In respect of a Stage Carriage/City bus/Omni Bus Rs. 300/- per year.

The Registering Authorities are hereby authorized to issue base permits for all category of Passenger Service Vehicles on the basis of which the State Transport Authority shall issue All India Tourist Permit Authorization, Inter-State Permits, All Nagaland Tourist Taxi Permits, Inter-District Contract Carriage (Bus) Permits, provided that the applicant must first obtain an assurance certificate from the State Transport Authority for issue of the above permits.

(ii) in cases where a notice has been issued for rejection of refund claim, in full or in part and where the time limit for issuance of order in terms of the provisions of sub-section (5), read with sub-section (7) of section 54 of the said Act falls during the period from the 15th day of April 2021 to the 30th day of May 2021, in such cases the time limit for issuance of the said order shall be extended to fifteen days after the receipt of reply to the notice from the registered person or the 31st day of May 2021, whichever is later.

This notification shall come into force with effect from the 15th day of April 2021.
